Application	The application form for the use of public land can be downloaded here. The application must be submitted together with a proposal. This must contain at least the following information: • Site plan showing the location of the food trucks (to scale) and seating arrangements • Duration of use • Overview of the menu • Price list • Crockery used (material) In addition, an application for a temporary catering licence must be submitted.	A standard online planning application must be submitted.
Deadlines	Applications for the use of public land and for the operation of a festival catering business must be submitted to the registry office by 30 November at the latest.	The planning application and the catering licence application must be submitted to the Planning Office by 30 November at the latest. Please note: this deadline applies only to traditional food trucks whose primary purpose is the sale of food. For food trucks covered in advertising for another company, the standard deadline for temporary WEF construction projects, including advertising, of 15 August applies.

Conditions for approval	During the annual meeting, the municipality of Davos generally only permits food trucks on public land at Arkadenplatz. Bubenbrunnenplatz is not available. The exact location will be determined by the municipality. Only traditional food trucks intended for the purpose of serving food are permitted on public land. Food trucks intended to serve as advertising for a company or organisation are not permitted on public land.	The planning authority approves applications for food trucks on private land, provided that all formal requirements have been met and there are no logistical or safety concerns.
Selection Criteria	Space on Arkadenplatz is limited. The Municipality would like to see a diverse range of food options on Arkadenplatz, including vegetarian and vegan dishes. For sustainability reasons, preference will be given to local suppliers. The granting authority may grant licences as soon as an application is received that meets the requirements.	The above applies.
Auflagen	The granting authority (Kleiner Landrat) demands fair pricing (no WEF surcharge!). Vendors must provide adequate seating themselves. The granting authority may impose further conditions, for example regarding sustainability (e.g. no plastic tableware, dedicated waste bins, etc.). Food trucks must not be used as advertising platforms for other companies.	The planning authority may impose conditions relating to sustainability (e.g. no plastic tableware, own waste bins, etc.) Food trucks must not be used as advertising platforms for other companies.
Costs	The costs will be charged in accordance with the standard terms and conditions (see details in the Konzept für Veranstaltungen und Anlässe auf öffentlichem Grund).	The minimum fee for building permits, i.e. CHF 300.00, will be charged.
